CLINIC STAFF

Petar Trifonov joined the Retrievers in the summer of 2009 as the Head Diving Coach for the UMBC Diving Team.

Trifonov has had an impressive diving career, winning more than 50 national championships in his native Bulgaria. The culmination point of his career was the appearance in the 1992 Summer Olympics in Barcelona, Spain.

After he finished his competitive career, Trifonov became a recognized coach and judge. He judged the USA Diving National Championships since 2001, and in 2008 was a coach at the FINA Junior Diving World Championships.

Trifonov's coaching career includes stints at the College of William and Mary and American University, and he has been coaching at the Montgomery Dive Club Team in Rockville, Md., for the past eight years.

In addition to coaching at UMBC, Trifonov is the Head Coach of the Retriever Dive Club at UMBC, which is geared towards youth divers in the Baltimore area.
